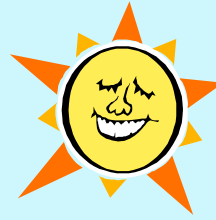


Seagrass

Small animals hide from big, hungry, fish in the seagrass

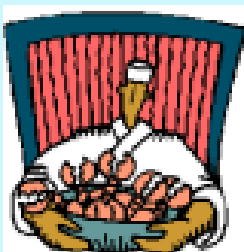
